4. RULES

Competitions conducted under the 2009-2012 BVT (Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of ISAF), the regatta regulations, the following instructions. 2005 "Fun Board" or Slalom Class Rules (Rules of IFCA class 2005) Competition Rules for 2009 (or 2009 IFCA Championship Rules)

5. WINDSURFING CLASS, AGE GROUPS AND CLASSIFICATIONS

FWC Formula (absolute, as well as age groups, including: Juniors under 18., Youth under 21., 35 –
- Masters. Grand Masters - from 45, Women). Competing according to the Formula Class.

FWC Formula B (Absolute B group standings). Participants will compete in this FWC group doing shorter distance using the Formula Class inventory without restrictions.

SL slalom (absolute group standings, as well as age groups: Juniors under 18., Youth under 21, 35 -
Masters. Grand Masters - from 45m., Women). Competing under "Fun Board" or Class Slalom.

SL slalom B ((The absolute group standings, as well as age groups: Juniors under 18., Youth under
21, 35 - Masters. Grand Masters - from 45m., Women). Competing under "Fun Board" or Slalom
Class rules without restriction on equipment.

Classes will be valid, if at least 5 competitors register.

6. APPLICATIONS

Applications for the race committee at the competition office equipped:

2011 13 May 17:00 to 21:00 hours.

2011 May 14 August 9:00 to 10:00 am.

7. ENTRY FEE

Adult 60Lt.

Up to 21 age 30Lt.

Up to 18 age 15Lt.

8. ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

Information for participants will be posted on a notice board.

9. RACE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHANGE

Any change race instructions will be posted on a notice board not later than one hour before the start of that race. Possible changes to instructions on the water, if it is possible to inform all the participants to the "Notification" signal. Any race, the changes will be made until 10:00 effective date.

10. SIGNALS SHORE

Signals (flags) to be lifted ashore together with the signal horn. "AP" flag is a provision for sailing and lifting will be accompanied by two acoustic signals, downing - one. "Warning" signal will be given at least 30 minutes after the lowering of "AP" flag.

11. COMPETITION SCHEDULE AND RACE SCHEDULE

2011 05 13 Friday

9:00 to 21:00 am. - Arrival Day

17:00 to 21:00 am Registration.

2011 05 14 Saturday:

9:00 to 10:00 Registration;

10:30 - Skippers meeting;

11:00 - The planned start date of the first race.

19:00 - Evening program.

2011 05 15 Sunday

9:00 - Skippers meeting;

10:00 - The planned start date of the first race.

16:00 - Start of the last race;

17:00 - winning awards and competitions close.

If by the given time not enough races are held the time for the last start and the award may be modified. This will be reported at the meeting.

12. CLASS FLAG

See Appendix. 1 (the bulletin board).

13. RACE AREA and distance

Distance of the scheme will be drawn at the skippers meeting and their signs will be constructed on a daily basis, depending on wind direction.

14. STARTS

14.1. Start procedure, distance:

1st SL, SL-B, if the wind exceeds 11 knots (6 m / s).

2nd FWC, FWC-B, if the wind is greater than 7 knots (3.5 m / s).

14.2. Other races of that day of sailing for the classes can be given to all members of the class finished, or windsurfing at the end of the control period. Above the sequence is optional.

14.3. Start is given if the start of at least two of the Class sailboards.

14.4. Individual and total cancellation of the signals will be kept for 2 min.

14.5. The start line is between the board of judges mark and the mark "1F".

14.6. Start is open for two minutes.

14.7. For each race will be subject to rule 30.1 (bypass the line ends). Whenever possible, will be published in the windsurfers who violated this rule, the sail numbers.

14.8. After a general recall will be subject to rule 30.3 (Black Flag Rule).

15. SHIPS OF THE JUDGES NEAR MARKS

15.1. In the absence of the mark, it should be regarded as the judges raised the flag of the vessel "M".

15.2. Lack of judges to mark the ship may not be the basis to demand the restoration result. This changes rule 62.1. (A).

16. FINISH

Finish line is between the judge and the stern of the vessel of judges for the "2F".

17. Control time

Windsurfers, which finished later than 15 minutes. after the first competitor of the Class, will be held unfinished (DNF).

18. PROTESTS

18.1. Protest must be written in a special form, which can be obtained from the Secretariat and the race must be submitted to the secretariat of the competition at one hour after ship of the judges returns to port. The protest period will be posted on the board.

18.2. The same is true of the opposition all the time the race committee and looking at the opposition, as well as requests for restoration of the result.

18.3. Protests will be considered in their order of receipt, as soon as possible, but not earlier than 30 minutes after the time of expiry.

18.4. Information about protests will be posted on the board within 30 minutes before the time of expiry.

18.5. Decisions of the protest Committee - final.

18.6. Protest fee - 20 Lt.

19. RESULTS

Will be used for "linear" (Low Point System) scoring system.

20. AWARDS

Cups and diplomas will be awarded the FW, FW-B, SL, SL-Class B, 1-3 credits of absolute plae. In other places 1-3 places will be awarded with diplomas. Also, FWC B first place will be awarded with a transitional Cup.

21. VESSELS

Attendance, team leaders, coaches and support staff should not be racing in and be followed by the 100 distance from the windsurfing area, from "the preparatory" signal time to finish all the competitors point in time except for emergency cases. For violations of this prohibition windsurfer regarding the offender may be disqualified.

22. Radio, mobile telephony and GPS tools

Windsurfer could have active communication and GPS instruments, but they can only be used at the rescue. Before the start and during the race use of radio and GPS is prohibited.

23. SECURITY

23.1. Windsurfing, withdrew from the race to think of it as soon as possible to notify the race committee.

23.2. Individual life-saving measures for participants under 18 years of age must wear a full time presence on the water.

24. RESPONSIBILITY

All the risks associated with the decision to participate in competitions, the participant accepts himself personally in accordance with Rule 4 "Decision to participate in the race." Organizers shall not be liable for the lives of participants in the inventory losses related to the matches, before or after them.

25. ACCOMMODATION

Participants during the competition live at their own expense. For campsites "Ventainė" please contact the camp administration and the residence of the phone book. Tell them to come take part in competitions and you will receive a special discount.
